Social Rules:

1. Every student must sign out in the proper book if she expects to be out betw een the hours of 10pm and 7 \$50am. She must state the time by which she will return, and as specifically as possible how and w here she may be reached. The hour of expected return must bear appropriate relation to the student la costination. When she returns, the student must sign in stating the time at w hich she has returned.

2. If a student plans to be out overnight she must sign out in the evernight book stating as specifically as possible how and wrantershe may Exterime of expetteleturo

3. Sign-outs may be changed in person by the student until the hour to w hich she is signed out, or by telephone according to dofm regulations.

4. If a student finds that an energency prevents her return by the bour to which she is signed out, she is expected to telephone the head resident if she will be more than half an hour late. This measure by no means excuses her lateness, but in cases of unaveidable delay it is a compensatory factor.

5. Any student whose academic for social record is unsatisfactory may have her privileges curtailed by the Administrative Board or the Beard of Hall Presidents.

6. Freshmen ! a) First term freshmen may sign out until 11:15 pm any night.

. b) Freshmen may sign out until 1 o'clock thirty (30) times before the first exam period.

Each night of an evernight permission will count as a loclock. Before Thanksgiving freshmen must ask permission to be out after

After Thanksgiving, Freshmen must ask permission to be out after 11:15 pm. 1 elcleck. Permission should be obtained from the head resident. If the head resident is not available the student may ask any member of the dormitory committee who is not a freshman.

d) Freshmen must ask permission to be out after 3am or evernight from her head resident or the head resident on duty.

To Sephomores a) Before Thanksgiving, sophomores must ask permission to some out . after lie clock. Permission should be obtained from the head resident. If the head resident is not available the student may ask any member of the dormitory committee who is not a freshman.

b) Before Thanksgiving, sophomores must ask permission to be out after 3 am or overnight from the head resident or the head resi-

dent on duty.

Penalties:

1. Infractions of the rules will be dealt with by the dorm committee.

2. Sases may be referred to Beard of Hall Presidents by the dormitory committee or the dormitory president.

3. Any student may appeal a decision of the dormitory committee to the Board of Hall Presidents.

Checking Books 1. Books will be checked efficially at 1:30 am by a member of the dormitory committee or in the designated by the dormitory committee. 2. Books will be officially checked in the morning by the first girl on bells. As an additional safeguard, beeks will be shocked after 1450 am by the night watchman and be every student w ho returns after 1:30 am. will to asked tocheck books.
